#### I. Purpose

Alamo Area Athletic Trainers' Association is committed to the encouragement of area High School Student Athletic Trainers as they attempt to further their education. The AAATA sponsors two annual \$250 scholarships to an area High School Student Athletic Trainer who has been accepted to a college or university of their choice.

The Charles Cortez / Eddie Mizicko Memorial High School Scholarship, presented by the AAATA, is to provide a scholarship to a deserving high school graduating senior intending to pursue a collegiate or university degree in any field.

#### II. Criteria

- A. Applicant must be a high school senior in good academic standing with a GPA of 80 or above, or a 3.0 or above (include copy of high school transcript with application).
- B. Minimum of two years' experience, or in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year as a High School student athletic trainer, under the supervision of an AAATA member is required.
- C. Applicant must be committed to pursuing a collegiate or university degree.
- D. If the applicants' high school has a full time athletic trainer, they must currently be an active member of the Alamo Area Athletic Trainers' Association by the May 1<sup>st</sup> deadline, and be willing to sponsor the applicant.
- E. If the applicant's high school does not have a full time athletic trainer, they must be sponsored by a currently active member of the Alamo Area Athletic Trainers' Association.

## **III. Application Process**

- A. Application may be obtained from AAATA Scholarship Chairman, or from the AAATA website.
- B. The following documentation must be submitted together with the completed application form:
  - 1. A letter of recommendation from the <u>sponsoring Athletic Trainer</u> to include references as to character, work habits, attitude, professionalism, contributions to the high school programs, and aptitude for the profession.
  - 2. A letter of recommendation from a <u>head coach</u>, <u>teacher</u>, <u>counselor</u>, <u>administrator or team physician</u> to include references as to character, work habits, attitude, professionalism, contributions to the high school programs, and aptitude for the profession.
  - 3. Others are appreciated
- C. Current Résumé
- D. Acceptance letter from a college or university registrar as proof of acceptance to that institution.
- E. ACT and/or SAT scores.
- F. Write an essay which should include the following:
  - 1. Applicant's career goals/plans.
  - 2. About the applicant's experience/time in their high school athletic training program.
  - 3. Site 5 year goals and 10 year goals.

#### G. Application deadline: May 1<sup>st</sup> (post marked)

H. Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student's institution, upon evidence of acceptance into a college or university. This includes student identification number and correct address of school's Financial Aid Office.

#### **IV. Selection Committee**

- A. Composition of the selection committee will be as follows:
  - 1. Scholarship chairman
  - 2. AAATA Vice President
  - 3. AAATA Past President

B. If the selection committee is unable to select an appropriate candidate, the scholarship money will not be awarded.

# Notification

Final Scholarship winner will be notified in late June. Additional information may be required before completing the award process.

## **Applicant:**

If you choose to not pursue a collegiate or university degree within 1 year of high school graduation, the scholarship will be forfeited and any remaining balance will be returned to the AAATA.
